POLICY FOR TRANSPORTING CHILDREN TO AND FROM CRICKET RELATED ACTIVITIES

Statement of Intent

Parents and carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches, at home and away venues, and at training sessions. Club officials are responsible for the children in their care when on the club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds. It is not the responsibility of coaches, team managers, or team captains to transport, or arrange transport for, children to and from any cricket related activity. This policy is based on the ECB guidelines on transporting children to and from matches, published in June 2013.

Putting this policy into place at Grantham Cricket Club

- The Club will ensure that parents are notified of the planned training sessions and fixtures at the beginning of the Season, to allow parents and carers as much notice as possible to make appropriate travel arrangements.
- Parents are able to agree lift sharing between themselves as appropriate.
- Club coaches and team managers are not permitted by the Club to transport children in their vehicles to matches or training sessions.
